AEL EGYPT JORDAN

Day 1, Mon, May 7 •Depart Seattle at 8:45 a.m. on US Airways via Philadelphia for your overnight flight to Tel Aviv.

<u>Day 2, Tues, May 8</u> • Arrive in Tel Aviv in the afternoon. We will meet our guide and transfer to the Blue Bay Hotel in Netanya, on Mediterranean Sea.

Day 3, Wed, May 9 • Begin the day at Caesarea Maritima. See the well-preserved aqueducts, Hippodrome and Theatre. We then visit Mt. Carmel to see the site where Elijah defeated the prophets of Baal. Continue to Megiddo to visit the site of 26 superimposed cities and view the Plains of Jezreel where the Battle of Armageddon will be fought. We will visit a replica village in Nazareth built on remains from 2,000 years ago. Walk through a working farm, and see replica homes and a synagogue. Overnight at Maagan Hotel on the Sea of Galilee.

Day 4, Thurs, May 10 • Start the day sailing across the Sea of Galilee in a 2,000 year old replica boat. Visit the ancient "Jesus" boat consistent with boats built from 100BC to AD200. Next, travel to Capernaum, the city of Jesus, to see the ancient synagogue where Jesus taught and the Apostle Peter's home. Walk on the Mount of Beatitudes and then visit Tabgah where Jesus fed 5,000. Next we stop at Chorizim, the city that rejected Jesus.

Day 5, Fri, May 11 • Today, travel to the northern part of Israel. At Banias, one of the headwaters of the Jordan River, visit the site of ancient Caesarea Philippi. Walk through the beautiful nature reserve of Tel Dan, see Jeroboam's Altar and an ancient Canaanite Gate. Travel to the Golan Heights, look into Syria and see remains from the Six Day War. End the day with an

opportunity to be baptized in the Jordan River. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

Day 6, Sat, May 12 • Driving down the Jordan Valley, stop to explore Beit Shean, Israel's largest excavation. It was on the walls of Beit Shean that the Philistines hung the bodies of King Saul and his sons. Visit the natural springs where Gideon chose 300 men to fight the Midianites. Drive by Jericho and the Mount of Temptations to the lowest spot on earth, the Dead Sea. We will see the caves of the Dead Sea Scrolls discovery, Qumran, before arriving at the Leonardo Hotel for an evening of relaxation, take advantage of the spa facilities, or "float" in the therapeutic waters of the Dead Sea.

Day 7, Sun, May 13 • Enjoy a morning of leisure before visiting Masada. We tour this famous archaeological site where Jewish Zealots made their last stand against Rome in AD73. We stop at Ein Gedi to see the waterfall where David hid from Saul. We enter the city of the Kings: Jerusalem. Stopping at Mt. Scopus, we will have a magnificent view of City before arriving at the Prima Royale hotel where we stay for the remainder of our tour.

Day 8, Mon, May 14 • Our Jerusalem journey begins at the Mt. of Olives. Then we will walk down the road where Jesus made his triumphal entry into the city, then to Dominus Flevit where Jesus wept over the city. Next we visit the Garden of Gethsemane, where He spent that agonizing night of prayer before His betrayal and arrest. We walk across the Kidron Valley to Mt. Zion. We will visit Caiaphas' House where Jesus was held before trial. We walk to the top of the Herodium, a man-made hill where Herod built one of his magnificent palaces. Recently archeologists have found what

they believe to be Herod's Tomb. We will spend the remainder of the day in Bethlehem, the birthplace of Jesus to see the traditional site of his birth and the Shepherds field where the birth of Jesus was announced.

<u>Day 9, Tues, May 15</u> • We begin this morning at the City of David. Just outside the Old City Walls lies original Jerusalem. Recent excavations have revealed the walls, palaces and passages ways of King David's Jerusalem. We then enter the Old City at the Jewish Quarters. Here we will see the ancient Roman Cardo and the broad wall of Hezekiah. We will walk through the remains of of a six-house compound of Aristocratic families that were destroyed with the destruction of the Second Temple. We then come to the Temple Institute to see vessels and tools that are being prepared for the future temple. We walk to the Western Wall to enjoy a personal time of prayer before touring its underground tunnels. At the Davidson Center, we will experience a virtual tour of the Temple and then explore the Southern Steps, entrance to the Temple during the time of Christ.

Day 10, Wed, May 16. We start the day at the Temple Mount, then walk through the Old City to the Pools of Bethesda where Jesus healed the lame man. Next we stop at Antonio Fortress where we will see carvings in the stone floor of a cruel game played by Roman Soldiers during the time of Christ. Continuing through the Old City, we follow the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, one of the sites believed to the site of the crucifixion. Then to the Upper Room, the traditional site of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. The remainder of the day is free time to explore on your own.

Day 11, Thurs, May 17. A late start this morning allowing time to prepare for your flight home. We then travel to the Israel Museum where we will see the Dead Sea Scrolls and a miniature model of Jerusalem during the time of Christ. We will drive by Israel's parliament, the Knesset. End our time in Jerusalem with worship and communion at the Garden Tomb. Enjoy a delightful farewell dinner before transferring to the airport for departure.

<u>Day 12, Fri, May 18</u> • Arrive home 12:52 p.m. with a lifetime of memories of our Journey through Israel.
