Tour Itinerary

Day 1, Tues, Dec 29—Depart Dallas/Fort Worth on United Airlines at 3:15pm for our flight to Tel Aviv.

Day 2, Wed, Dec 30—We arrive at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv in the late afternoon and begin our journey through Israel. Our first stop, time permitting, is Joppa, one of the oldest cities in the world, the home of Simon the Tanner and the port from which the prophet Jonah set sail for Tarshish. We then transfer to the Islands Hotel in Netanya.

Day 3, Thurs, Dec 31—We travel to Caesarea Maritima where we will see a well-preserved Roman Theater, remains from Herod's Palace, a Hippodrome, and the aqueducts. We will visit Mt. Carmel, where Elijah challenged the 450 prophets of Baal. Continue to Megiddo and see the site of 25 superimposed cities, the remains from Solomon's days, and view the Plains of Jezreel where the final Armageddon will be fought. Drive by Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus. Next we will enjoy a special time of worship as we sail across the Sea of Galilee in a replica boat of 2,000 years ago. Continue to Nof Ginosar at the Sea of Galilee.

Day 4, Fri, Jan 1—Today we explore the northern part of Israel. We drive to Banias, one of the headwaters of the Jordan River and site of ancient Caesarea Philippi where Jesus asked His disciples, "Who do men say that I am?" Walking through the beautiful nature reserve of Tel Dan we will see remains from Jeroboam's Altar and ancient Canaanite mud brick gate from the time of Abraham, then enjoy a lunch of St. Peter's Fish on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. Travel to the traditional site of the Sermon on the Mount, the Mount of Beatitudes. At the beautiful Yardenit baptismal site, you will have the opportunity to be baptized in the Jordan River. Overnight at Nof Ginosar.

Day 5, Sat, Jan 2—We begin our day visiting the ancient boat discovered by two fishermen in 1986 during a time of drought. At Capernaum, the center of Jesus' activities in Galilee and home to Peter, Andrew, James and John, we will see the house of Peter where Jesus healed Peter's mother in law and see the ancient synagogue where Jesus taught. Visit Tabgha where Jesus fed 5,000 on the shores of the Galilee, then see Peter's Primacy, where Jesus restored Peter. Leaving the Galilee area, we drive down the Jordan Valley to explore Beit Shean. Walk through this ancient city and see a gymnasium, bathhouse, theatre, public toilets, shops and temples. We drive to Jerusalem and stop for a magnificent view of Jerusalem from Mt. Scopus. Overnight at the Dan Hotel in Jerusalem where we will stay for the remainder of our tour.

Day 6, Sun, Jan 3—Today we begin at the Mount of Olives. As we walk down the Palm Sunday Road, stop at Dominus Flavit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. Continue to the Church of All Nations at the Garden of Gethsemane. We enter the Old City and see the Pools of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the lame man, then follow the Via Dolorosa through the Old Arab markets to the Lithostrotos at Sisters of Zion where we will see the markings of a cruel game used by the

Roman soldiers during the time of Christ. We end the day in Bethlehem.

Day 7, Mon, Jan 4—Returning to the Old City we visit the Jewish Quarter where we see the ancient Roman Cardo, and remains from Hezekiah's Wall. At the Herodian Mansion we will walk through archeological remains of a six-house compound, homes of aristocratic and Temple Priest families that were destroyed with the destruction of the 2nd Temple in 70 AD. At the Temple Institute we visit the organization that is preparing tools and vessels for the future Jewish Temple. We will see the Upper Room, the traditional site of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit and Last Supper. We end our day at Mount Zion as we visit St. Peter of Galicantu, Caiaphas' House, where Jesus was held before trial, and see ancient steps that led to the city, a path Jesus may have used.

Day 8, Tues, Jan 5—Today we will travel to the lowest spot on earth, the Dead Sea. We will visit Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Ascending by cable car, we will tour the famous archaeological site of Masada, an ancient fortress where Jewish Zealots made their last stand against Rome in 73 AD. We stop at Ein Gedi to hike to the waterfalls where David hid from Saul. Before returning to Jerusalem, we take time to "float" in the therapeutic waters of the Dead Sea.

Day 9, Wed, Jan 6—We start today at the new excavations of the City of David revealing some of the most exciting archeological finds of the ancient world. Archeologists have found what they believe is King David's Palace that has been undisturbed for over 3,000 years. Walk through a 1,700 foot tunnel dug during the reign of Hezekiah, and see the recently discovered Pools of Siloam. Walk through a newly discovered tunnel to the Davidson Center where we will enjoy a virtual tour of the Second Temple, then explore the Temple Southern Steps. These steps were the only entrance for all who visited the Temple during the time of Christ. Next visit the Western Wall for a personal time of reflection and prayer, then walk through the Western Wall Tunnel.

Day 10, Thurs, Jan 7—We begin our final day visiting areas of New Jerusalem. We will see the Knesset, Israel's parliament. Next, tour the Shalom Jerusalem Center. We walk through Yad Vashem, the Holocaust Museum, in memory of the millions of Jews murdered by the Nazis. Then visit the Israel Museum and see the miniature model of Jerusalem from the time of Christ and the Shrine of the Book to see some of the Dead Sea Scrolls found at Qumran. We end the day at one of the sites believed to be the burial site of Jesus, the Garden Tomb, a highlight of our tour as we enjoy a time of worship and communion.

Day 11, Fri, Jan 8—Depart on United #85 for our flight home. Arrive in Dallas on United #1072 at 9:19pm with a lifetime of memories of our Journey to the Holy Land.
