

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

Terms and Conditions: Registration is made with a \$500 deposit per person. Registrations received within 90 days of departure will be assessed a \$100 late fee and must be accompanied by payments required by that date. Expenses incurred as a result of payments required by that date. Expenses incurred as a result of expediting documents or information are the responsibility of the passenger. Seats are limited and tour will be closed when filled. All rates are in US dollars, per person, double occupancy.
